Bunte Truppe (feat. Limpe Fuchs): Träumen ohne Dinge

Disembodied Dreams

As can be ascertained from the programmatic introduction, the group's name appears first, followed by the various musicians involved and their respective instruments. It might be worth mentioning when the Bunte Truppe was actually founded. The attentive reader will notice that Limpe Fuchs, Ruth-Maria Adam, Ignaz Schick and Ronnie Oliveras started performing together in 2017 with a battery of percussion, wind and string instruments, as well as numerous electronic aids. At this point, it is extremely important to describe how such a colourful troupe can remain at the cutting edge of contemporary music, moving effortlessly between different musical genres with their improvisations. It goes without saying that this rather exaggerated claim assumes that the Bunte Truppe can challenge their audience in this way. But of course! Anything else worth mentioning? Attention could be drawn to historical contexts and other cultural connections, for example the fact that Limpe Fuchs has been around as a musician for God knows how long (for a time in the free improv duo Anima-Sound), and is widely known internationally; or that Ruth-Maria Adam and Ronnie Oliveras also go on the rampage with Datashock and the Flamingo Creatures; whilst Ignaz Schick rushes from one Artist in Residency to the other with a record player under his arm. These facts may or may not be important. Similarly, in order to put their music in perspective, it may or may not be helpful to draw comparisons with other international benchmarks. However, before we get lost in the labyrinth of music, let's rather prick up our ears and devote our attention to the astonishing sounds hiding in this recording: full of life and seemingly carefree, but (at the same time) always heedful of each other, the members of the Bunte Truppe start playing as free as a bird, and manage to unite apparently incompatible musical opposites without any effort. The material cannot be mastered, it has suffered enough already. Holger Adam.

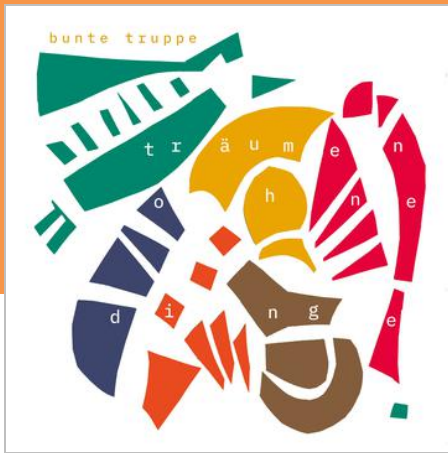

Selbstverständlich schließt diese vollmundige Ankündigung mit ein, dass die Bunte Truppe es auf diesem Wege versteht, ihr Publikum herauszufordern! Natürlich. Was noch? Hinweise auf historische Kontexte oder andere kulturelle Zusammenhänge, wie zum Beispiel, dass Limpe Fuchs ja nun schon seit Gott-weiß-wie-lange (und viele Jahre davon im Free-Improv-Duo Anima-Sound) als Musikerin international bekannt und unterwegs ist; dass Ruth-Maria Adam und Ronnie Oliveras unter anderem auch bei Datashock und den Flamingo Creatures Krach schlugen; während Ignaz Schick mit dem Plattenspieler unterm Arm von Artist Residency zu Artist Residency eilt, sind auch (nicht) wichtig. Ebenso (wenig) hilfreich mag es sein, zur Orientierung die eine oder andere internationale Vergleichsgröße zur Einordnung der Musik heran zu ziehen. Doch bevor wir uns in der Musikbibliothek verlaufen, spitzen wir lieber die Ohren und widmen uns den erstaunlichen Klängen, die diese Schallplatte birgt:

Munter und scheinbar unbekümmert, aber aufmerksam füreinander spielt die Bunte Truppe drauf los & sich frei, und so findet vermeintlich Unvereinbares, musikalisch Disparates zwanglos zusammen. Das Material will nicht beherrscht werden, es hat schon genug gelitten. (Holger Adam)

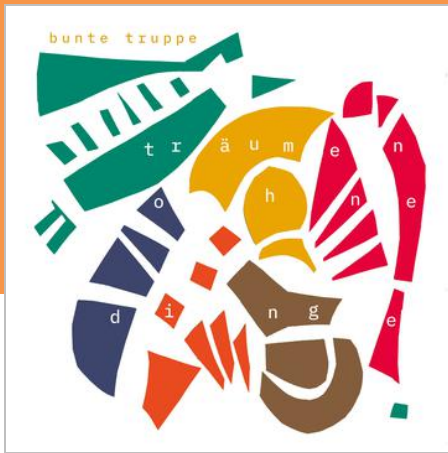

play loud's intention is to re-release the entire catalogue by Anima-Sound, Anima and Limpe Fuchs (solo work).

Some of the records, tapes, films have been released illegally over the years, some others have been out of print for decades. The artists often times were not paid. play loud! is working directly with Limpe Fuchs. Stay also tuned for some recordings and/or films that never had been released before. Please support our attempt to restore and archive this important music.

Limpe Fuchs is a legend in the experimental music scene. In the late sixties, this percussionist drummed on self-made instruments, together with her then husband Paul Fuchs, in the Ensemble Anima. During that time, Limpe and Paul Fuchs cooperated with the classic pianist star Friedrich Gulda, as well as with jazz luminaries like Albert Mangelsdorff, and continually attracted the interest of their audiences in new constellations. Limpe Fuchs' solo performance with "variable wood and stone rows, ringing bronze in the pendulum strings, and a variety of skin and bronze drums" is a rare occasion to witness one of the early avantgardists of the scene from the old Federal Republic Of Germany. She attempts, while playing live, to develop her musical ideas from the "resonance of the location where the performance takes place" - "to make music in the flow of time, with simplicity and emotion"!
